Grounding provides a low-impedance path for fault currents, which helps prevent electric shock to personnel and protects equipment from damage due to lightning strikes, transient overvoltages, or insulation failures . It also stabilizes voltage levels within the distribution system, ensuring that protective devices like circuit breakers operate correctly during faults . Without proper grounding, metallic parts of the distribution box, including doors and enclosures, can become live and pose serious hazards .

Code Requirements



According to the National Electrical Code (NEC), all metallic parts of electrical boxes, including distribution boxes and cabinet doors, must be bonded to ground using designated grounding screws or clips . NEC 250.148 specifically mandates bonding of metallic junction boxes, while NEC 314.28 requires that metal boxes be reliably grounded. Equipment grounding conductors must be sized appropriately to carry fault currents and allow overcurrent devices to clear faults safely .

Practical Grounding Methods

- **Connection to Grounding Bar:** Attach a ground wire from the distribution box or cabinet to a dedicated grounding bar or central grounding point .
- **Door and Enclosure Bonding:** Metal doors should have a separate grounding wire to the cabinet's grounding bar to prevent static discharge and ensure safety if internal faults occur .
- **Wire Sizing:** In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) ground wire is typically used, while other markets may require a 6 mm² wire .
- **Resistance Requirements:** The total ground resistance between system parts should be very low, typically less than 0.1 ohm, to ensure effective fault current flow .

Additional Considerations

- **Supplementary Grounding:** For sensitive equipment, isolated or insulated grounding systems may be used to reduce electrical noise while still providing a reliable fault path .
- **Material Quality:** Use corrosion-resistant materials for grounding rods and conductors to maintain long-term reliability .
- **Testing:** Grounding systems should be tested to verify resistance and continuity, ensuring compliance with safety standards . In summary, grounding all primary distribution boxes is mandatory for safety, code compliance, and reliable operation of the electrical system. Proper installation, bonding of metallic parts, and adherence to resistance and wire sizing standards are essential to achieve effective grounding.
