Conduits are rigid or flexible tubes that provide maximum protection for cables in harsh or outdoor environments. They are ideal for industrial, outdoor, or high-risk installations, offering resistance to mechanical damage, moisture, and chemical exposure. Conduits are less flexible for modifications compared to trays or baskets but excel in durability and compliance with safety standards .
