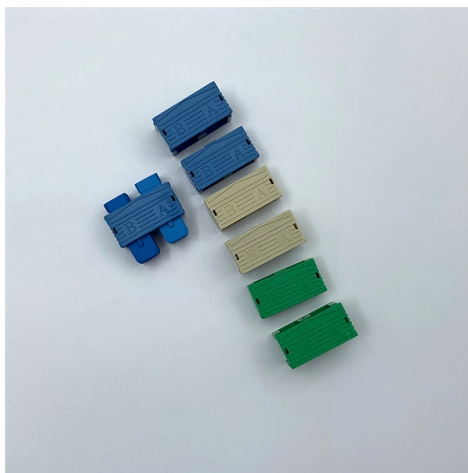

- Elevate reels off the ground to prevent water accumulation and soil contact .
