Direct Fiber Connection

It is possible to connect a fiber optic cable directly to a switch optical port if the cable is terminated with the correct connector type (e.g., LC, SC) that matches the switch port. However, several precautions are necessary:

- Ensure the optical module type matches the switch port and cable type (single-mode vs. multi-mode).

- Verify that the wavelengths of the transceivers on both ends are compatible.
- Confirm that the transmit power and receiver sensitivity are within the supported range for the switch .
- Maintain proper handling to avoid fiber damage or contamination, as fiber optics are sensitive to dust and bending .

Practical Considerations

While direct connection is feasible, many setups use patch panels or fiber distribution panels to simplify management, reduce stress on cables, and allow easier troubleshooting . In small cabinets or limited space, direct connection is acceptable, but care must be taken to avoid repeated plugging and unplugging, which can degrade the fiber connectors.
