If your China Unicom GPON terminal cannot be opened, it is likely due to registration failure, IP/subnet issues, or incorrect credentials. Check Device Registration and Status

A GPON ONU must register with the OLT to go online. If the ONU shows as offline, it indicates a registration failure. You can verify this by running the display ont info command on the OLT, which will show the ONU's Run state as either offline or online . Common causes of registration failure include:

- Incorrect SN or password configured on the OLT compared to the ONU.
 - Distance exceeding the OLT's ranging compensation.
 - OLT deactivation of the ONU.
 - Multiple ONUs failing simultaneously may indicate a PON port or OLT issue .
- Verify Physical Connections

Ensure that the fiber cable is properly connected and not bent or damaged. Check the ONU indicators:

- PON/LOS off: No fiber signal; check the fiber connection.
- PON blinking: Connecting; wait a few minutes.
- LAN off: Bad Ethernet cable; try swapping cables .

Accessing the ONU Management Interface

To configure or open the ONU:

- Connect your computer directly to the ONU via Ethernet.
- Determine the ONU's IP address (commonly 192.168.1.1 or 192.168.0.1) by checking your PC's default gateway using ipconfig on Windows .
- Ensure your PC is in the same subnet as the ONU (e.g., if ONU is 192.168.1.1, set PC to 192.168.1.x).
- Open a web browser and enter the ONU IP. Use the default username and password or the credentials provided by China Unicom .
- If the ONU is on a different subnet, you may need to add a VIP on your router/WAN interface and configure NAT rules to access it .

Resetting the ONU

If access still fails:

- Press the reset button on the ONU for 10 seconds to restore factory settings. This will erase all custom configurations, so you may need to reconfigure the ONU or contact China Unicom for reprogramming .

Additional Tips

- Temporarily disable firewall or antivirus that may block local IP access.
- Confirm that no IP conflicts exist on your network.
- If using multiple ONUs, ensure each has a unique SN and MAC address recorded before installation . Following these steps should help you identify whether the issue is due to authentication, network configuration, or physical connection, and allow you to access and configure your China Unicom GPON terminal.
