

Configuring the optical port on the new switch

Proper configuration of an optical port involves careful installation of the transceiver, cleaning and connecting the fiber, and setting interface parameters such as speed, aggregation, or split mode. Physical Installation and Safety

- ESD Protection: Always wear a grounded wrist strap and work on an ESD-safe mat to prevent electrostatic discharge from damaging the transceiver or switch port .
- Handling Transceivers: Hold the SFP or QSFP module by the sides or metal cage. Never touch the optical bore or gold contacts .
- Cleaning: Keep transceivers and fiber connectors clean. Use approved fiber cleaning kits or lint-free wipes with isopropyl alcohol. Avoid touching connector ends to prevent contamination and signal loss .
- Insertion: Align the module key with the port keyway and slide it straight in until it clicks. Do not force the module; if resistance is felt, remove and recheck orientation .



- Dust Caps: Keep protective caps on until ready to connect. Remove them immediately before connecting the fiber .

Connecting the Optical Cable

- Identify the correct optical port on the switch, usually labeled SFP, Mini-GBIC, or Optical .
- Confirm the type of connector (LC, SC, ST) and ensure compatibility with the switch and remote device .
- Insert the fiber connector straight into the transceiver until it clicks. Ensure the cable is not bent sharply to avoid damage .

Software Configuration

- Access the CLI: Connect to the switch console using an RJ-45 rollover cable or terminal emulator (VT100) to configure the optical port .
- Set Interface Attributes: Depending on the switch model, configure speed, duplex, and auto-negotiation. For example, on Huawei CX320 switches, you can aggregate or split high-bandwidth interfaces using commands like `port aggregate aggregate-type 4*10ge interface { interface-type interface-number }` .
- Interface Split: A 40GE port can be split into four 10GE interfaces. Ensure the remote device supports the same configuration and optical modules with matching wavelengths are installed .
- Save and Restart: After configuration, save the settings and restart the switch to apply changes. Be cautious with rollback commands, as original interface settings may not be restored automatically .
- Verify Connectivity: Check interface status indicators. Ports may remain down if there is a mismatch in auto-negotiation or module type .

Best Practices

- Avoid repeated removal and insertion of transceivers to extend their lifespan .
- Regularly inspect ports and connectors for dust or damage.
- Ensure the optical module type and speed match the remote device to prevent link failures .
- When using interface aggregation or split, start with the first port in the sequence to maintain proper mapping and functionality . By following these steps, you can safely install and configure optical ports on a new switch, ensuring reliable high-speed connectivity and minimizing the risk of hardware or configuration errors.
