- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Converts incoming fiber optic light signals into electrical signals your router can use. Usually provided by your ISP .
- Fiber optic cable: Typically single-mode with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- Fiber-ready router: Ensure it supports gigabit or multi-gigabit speeds; modern routers with Wi-Fi 6 or higher are recommended .
- Ethernet cable (Cat6a or higher): Connects the ONT to your router to maintain optimal speeds .

Step-by-Step Installation

- Install the ONT
- Locate the fiber entry point in your home, often a wall outlet or NID (Network Interface Device) outside the house .
- Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's designated port.

- Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize (usually 2-5 minutes), .
- Connect the ONT to the Router
- Use a high-quality Ethernet cable to link the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to your router's WAN port .
- Power on the router and check that indicator lights confirm a successful connection.
- Router Configuration
- Access the router's web interface (commonly 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1) to configure network settings .
- Enable Quality of Service (QoS) if you plan to prioritize video calls, gaming, or VoIP traffic .
- Update firmware to ensure security and performance.
- Optimize Wi-Fi Coverage
- Place the router centrally in the house for even coverage .
- For larger homes, consider mesh Wi-Fi systems to extend coverage .
- Use wired connections for critical devices to maximize speed and reduce latency .

Additional Tips

- Handle fiber cables carefully; improper connections can degrade signal by over 30% .
- Avoid outdoor fiber cables with metal sheaths to maintain electrical isolation and prevent interference .
- Test internet speed after setup to confirm full performance and adjust router placement or settings as needed . By following these steps, your self-built house can achieve reliable, high-speed fiber internet, fully leveraging the advantages of fiber optics for streaming, gaming, and smart home devices .
