- Strip Buffer Layers:
 - For tight-buffered fiber (900 micron) and buffered fiber (250 micron), strip in small increments (about 1/4–3/8 inch or 6–8 mm at a time) to reduce stress on the fiber ().
 - Hold the stripper at a 45-degree angle to avoid nicking the fiber.
 - If the stripper has multiple grooves, use progressively smaller grooves to remove each buffer layer ().
 - Clean the Fiber: Use alcohol wipes or a microfiber cloth to remove any debris or residue from the stripped fiber ().
- Inspection and Quality Check
- Visual Inspection: Use a fiber optic microscope or visual fault locator (VFL) to ensure the fiber is clean, smooth, and free from nicks or scratches ().
 - Bend Test: Gently bend the stripped fiber about 45 degrees in all directions to check for hidden damage; a break indicates the fiber needs re-stripping ().
