The reason I ask is that on a Cisco 2901 router in an EHWIC card, you can insert the fiber optic SFP, but it does not go live until you. The SFP+ port is a high-speed optical-to-optical signal conversion port, mainly used for 10G Ethernet and Fiber Channel network applications. A key advantage of SFP+ Modules is that they are "hot-swappable", meaning they can be swapped out while the router is still powered on. It enables high-speed data transmission over fiber optic or copper cables, allowing network devices like switches and routers to interface with different types of communication media.
