Using switches or routers designed for high-speed fiber networks can also help maintain optimal performance.

- **Minimal Impact for Typical Use:** For most home or small business setups, a fiber splitter will not significantly reduce internet speed, especially if only a few devices are connected and the splitter is high-quality .
