

Does cold-joint need wire stripping



Overview

Proper stripping with wire strippers, pre-tinning stranded wires, cleaning with a damp sponge or wet sponge, and applying a small amount of solder correctly reduce defects such as excess solder and cold joints. Inspection and standards ensure reliability. Close handles until terminal or splice is held in place without deforming wire barrel 3. To crimp other half of splice, remove splice from tool, rotate splice 180°, reposition splice in tool and complete. When solder wire is not accurately heated during the soldering process, it can make solder joints that cause a poor connection. The cold solder junctions increase. Soldering wires is the process of joining electrical conductors using a melted filler metal to create strong, low-resistance connections.
