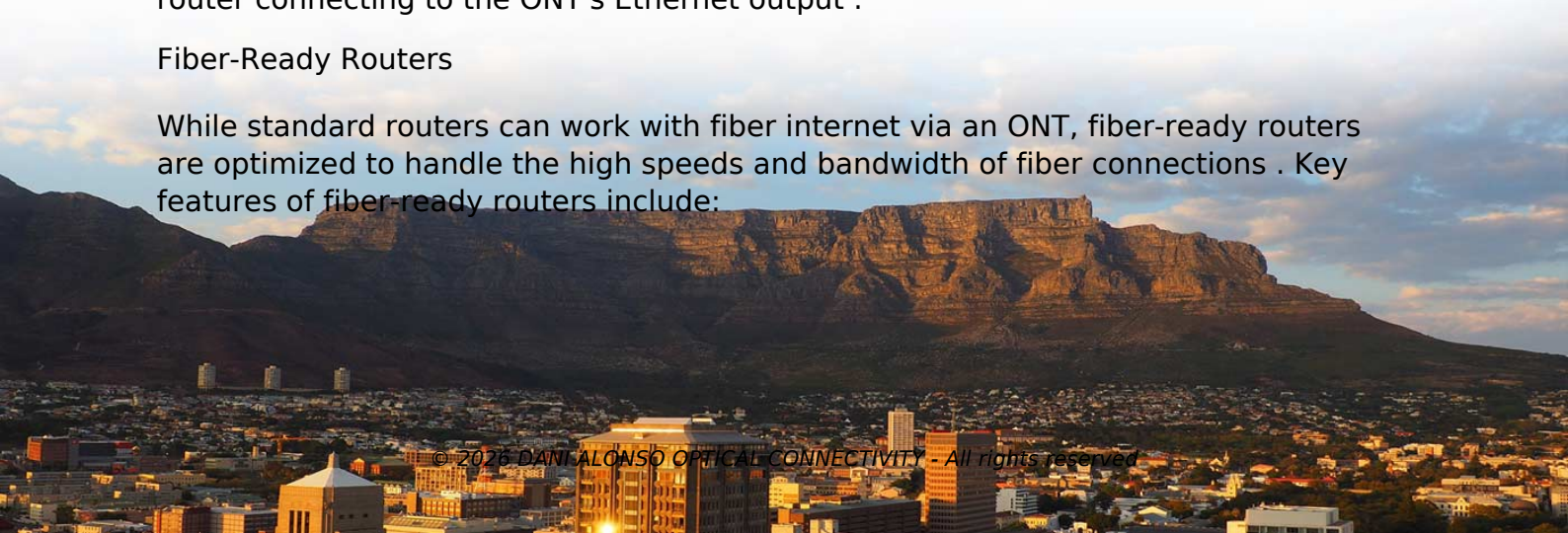

Fiber optic cables carry data as pulses of light, which cannot be directly interpreted by standard routers that use Ethernet ports for electrical signals . To bridge this gap, an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) is installed by your ISP. The ONT converts the light-based fiber signal into a standard Ethernet signal, which your router can then use to distribute internet throughout your home or office . Most residential setups use this two-device arrangement, with the fiber cable connecting to the ONT and the router connecting to the ONT's Ethernet output .

Fiber-Ready Routers

While standard routers can work with fiber internet via an ONT, fiber-ready routers are optimized to handle the high speeds and bandwidth of fiber connections . Key features of fiber-ready routers include:



- Gigabit or multi-gigabit Ethernet ports to match fiber speeds.
- Advanced wireless standards like Wi-Fi 6 or Wi-Fi 7 for faster wireless performance.
- WAN port compatibility for connecting to the ONT.
- Some high-end models include SFP/SFP+ ports, allowing direct connection to fiber transceivers, though this is less common in typical home setups .
