These boxes include three-phase terminals and are installed at a height of 120–140 cm in the machine room, secured with bolts and rawlplugs .

- Must be installed near the machine room or elevator control panel for easy access .
- Requires proper electrical wiring and initial elevator launch before installation .
- Cooling and dustproof features are important to maintain performance and prevent overheating .
- Installation should be performed by qualified technicians to ensure safety and compliance with electrical standards .
