FTTH drop cable is the final segment of the fiber network that connects the fiber distribution box (FDB) to the subscriber's premises, typically covering the last 50-300 meters of the network path . Installation Methods

Internal Home Routing

- Determine the final location of the Optical Network Terminal (ONT) near a power source and other networking hardware .
- Map the shortest and straightest path from the entry point to the ONT to minimize bends and stress on the fiber .
- Use existing conduits or low-voltage pathways where possible to reduce labor and avoid thermal or mechanical stress .
- Avoid areas with high heat, foot traffic, or sharp edges that could damage the cable jacket .

Equipment and Connectivity

For network extension beyond the drop cable:

- Media Converters can be used to connect fiber to Ethernet networks, ensuring proper polarity and signal conversion .
- Pre-terminated fiber assemblies simplify installation and reduce the need for splicing, making the process more plug-and-play .

Best Practices

- Always maintain proper bend radius and avoid sharp turns to prevent signal loss.
 - Use single-mode fiber for residential FTTH to ensure long-term performance.
 - Consider future-proofing by installing slightly longer or higher-capacity cables if upgrades are anticipated.
 - Ensure all connections are clean and properly terminated to minimize attenuation.
