- Power Down Equipment Before handling fiber optic cables, disconnect the power to the modem, router, or network device to eliminate the risk of exposure to invisible laser light and prevent electrical hazards .
- Identify Connector Type Common connectors include SC, SC/APC, and LC. SC connectors have a rectangular push-pull design, while LC connectors are smaller with a latch mechanism. Knowing the type helps you apply the correct release method .
- Release the Connector
 - For SC connectors, press the push-pull latch and gently pull the connector straight out along its axis.
 - For LC connectors, press the latch and pull straight without twisting. Avoid applying lateral force or bending the cable sharply, as this can damage the fiber or ferrule .
- Cap Exposed Ends Immediately place protective caps on both the disconnected cable and the port to prevent dust contamination and physical damage, which can degrade signal quality .

- **Handle with Care** Fiber optic cables are fragile. Use controlled, steady movements and avoid pulling on the cable itself. Velcro ties are preferred over vinyl to prevent sharp bends .

- **Inspect for Damage:** If connectors are corroded, stuck, or recessed, do not force removal. Contact a certified technician to avoid permanent damage .
- **Temporary vs Permanent Connections:** Connectors allow easy plug-and-play disconnection, unlike splicing, which is permanent. This makes connectors ideal for maintenance and network reconfiguration .
- **Testing After Reconnection:** After reconnecting, verify signal integrity to ensure no loss or attenuation occurred during disconnection . By following these steps, you can safely disconnect fiber optic cables while maintaining network performance and protecting the delicate fiber ends.
