The indicator lights on a fiber optic terminal box (ONT) show the status of power, network connection, data transmission, and alarms, with colors and patterns signaling normal operation or issues.

1. Power Light

- Green: ONT is powered and functioning normally.
- Red: Power issue or device malfunction.
- Off: No power or severe fault. This is the first light to check when troubleshooting, ensuring the device is receiving electricity ().

2. Optical/Fiber Light

- Green (steady): Fiber connection to the ISP is active and stable.
- Amber/Yellow: Attempting to establish a connection or weak signal.
- Red or Blinking: Connection failure or optical receiver issue.
- Off: No fiber connection detected. This light indicates the status of the fiber-optic link between your home and the service provider ().

3. Data/Ethernet Light

- Green (steady): Data is being transmitted successfully.

- Green (flashing): Internet is in use.
 - Amber/Yellow: Slow or intermittent data transmission.
 - Red: Data transmission failed.
 - Off: No data is being transmitted. This light shows the status of the Ethernet connection to your router or devices ().
- #### 4. Alarm Light
- Red (steady): ONT has detected an error or fault, such as loss of power or network issues.
 - Off: No errors detected. This light alerts you to any critical issues that may require troubleshooting ().
- #### Troubleshooting Tips
- Ensure all cables are securely connected.
 - Power cycle the ONT: turn off for 10–15 minutes, then turn back on and wait a few minutes for lights to stabilize ().
 - Check the power outlet with another device to confirm it is working.
 - If the optical light is off or red, inspect the fiber cable for damage or loose connections.
 - For persistent issues, contact your ISP for further support. Understanding these lights helps you quickly identify whether your fiber optic connection is functioning correctly or if intervention is needed ().
