- Prepare the Distribution Box
- Inspect the box and all components for damage or missing parts.
- Ensure the installation site is dry, accessible, and properly ventilated, typically at a height of around 1.5 meters .
- Gather necessary tools, including keys for locking mechanisms, screwdrivers, and multimeters for testing .
- Connect the Earth (E)
- Turn the Earth lock clockwise using the provided key to open the Earth cover .
- Fully raise the Earth cover and insert the Earth cable connector into the Earth socket.
- Push the connector fully until it stops and turn clockwise to lock it in place.

- The Earth connection is critical for safety and must be made first (FMLB – First Mate, Last Break) to ensure proper grounding .
- Connect the Neutral (N)
- Open the Neutral cover after the Earth is secured.
- Insert the Neutral connector into its socket, align the mechanical keying, push fully, and turn clockwise to lock.
- Note: In some 4-port boxes, the Neutral step may be skipped .
- Connect the Phase Lines (L1, L2, L3)
- Sequentially connect L1, L2, and L3 in order.
- For each phase:
- Open the corresponding cover.
- Align the connector with the keyed socket.
- Push fully and turn clockwise to lock.
- After L3 is connected, turn the L3 lock clockwise to secure the final connection .
- Safety and Verification
- Only fully assembled connectors should be inserted; unassembled insulators can misalign internal barrels .
- Once a cover is raised, the previous connection cannot be removed until the cover is closed, preventing accidental disconnection .
- Perform visual inspection and multimeter tests to verify correct connections and continuity before powering on .
- Final Steps
- Secure the box with the key locking system to restrict access to authorized personnel .
- Label all connections and circuits for future maintenance.
- Schedule regular inspections to ensure long-term reliability .

Additional Considerations

- Ensure all wiring complies with local electrical codes (NEC, IEC, or relevant standards), .
- Use appropriate wire gauges and protective devices such as breakers, fuses, and surge protectors for each circuit .

- Maintain neat cable management and proper insulation to prevent short circuits or overloads . Following this sequence ensures safe, reliable, and code-compliant installation of a Level 3 distribution box, minimizing the risk of electrical hazards and equipment damage.
