Galvanized steel cable trays are coated with zinc to protect against corrosion, but this coating does not provide significant fire resistance. Zinc melts at relatively low temperatures, which means that during a fire, the galvanized layer can fail quickly, and the tray itself may not prevent flame spread effectively. As a result, standard galvanized trays are suitable for low-risk environments but are not considered flame-retardant.

To improve fire resistance, galvanized trays can be treated with intumescent or fire-retardant coatings. These coatings form an insulating layer when exposed to heat, slowing down flame spread and increasing the tray's ability to withstand high temperatures. Without such treatment, galvanized trays alone cannot be relied upon for fire containment in high-risk areas like data centers, hospitals, or high-rise buildings.

Alternative Fire-Resistant Options

Other materials and designs offer better inherent fire resistance:

- FRP (fiberglass-reinforced plastic) trays: Non-conductive, corrosion-resistant, and inherently flame-retardant .
- Fire-coated steel trays: Steel trays with specialized fireproof coatings provide both structural strength and fire containment .
- Stainless steel or powder-coated trays: Offer durability and moderate fire performance but still benefit from additional fireproofing in high-risk environments .
