Each distribution box must be grounded using a dedicated ground wire. In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) wire is standard, while in other markets, a 6 mm² wire is recommended. The grounding wire should be attached from a threaded stud at the bottom of the box to the mounting plate, and then from the mounting plate to the central factory grounding point to ensure a continuous path for fault currents (Atlas Copco) .

Bending and Routing Considerations

When bending grounding wires inside the box:

- Ensure the bend radius is not too tight to avoid damaging the wire or insulation.
- Use flexible braided copper tape or stranded wire for connections between moving parts, such as doors or panels, to maintain conductivity (Goodeelec) .
- Apply conductive grease on stainless steel connections to reduce contact resistance and prevent corrosion.

- Use serrated or anti-loosening washers to pierce oxide layers and maintain a reliable electrical connection.

Resistance Requirements

The total grounding resistance between all system parts should be less than 0.1 Ohm. For longer tool cables or multiple spindles, additional ground wires may be required to reduce resistance. For example, a 16 mm² wire from the mounting plate to the spindle plate ensures proper grounding even with long cables, while in the US, a 6 AWG (13.29 mm²) wire is used (Atlas Copco) .

Testing and Verification

After installation:

- Measure the resistance from any point on the box to the main grounding electrode using a multimeter.
- Ensure the measured resistance meets safety standards. If it is too high, check for loose bolts, uncleaned surfaces, or insufficient contact area (Goodeelec) .
- For plastic or non-metallic boxes, connect a metal grounding plate or rod and verify continuity to the earth (LinkedIn) .

Practical Tips

- Avoid sharp bends that could stress the wire.
- Keep grounding paths as short and straight as possible.
- Ensure all conductive parts, including doors and panels, are bonded to the grounding system.
- For outdoor or industrial environments, maintain a complete conductive circuit to prevent step and touch hazards. By following these guidelines, the grounding bend and overall installation of a distribution box will provide a safe, low-resistance path for fault currents, protecting both equipment and personnel.
