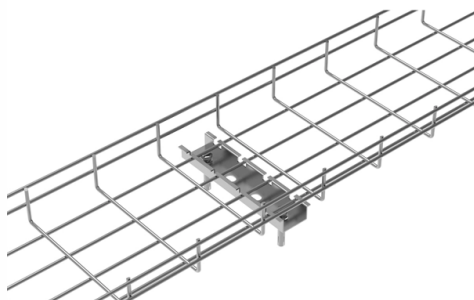


Grounding wire of distribution box PE

26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used. The correct connection method of Distribution box grounding wire mainly includes the following steps: 1.
