1. Planning and Material Preparation

Before installation, review the Bill of Quantities (BOQ) and approved shop drawings to verify tray types, sizes, and accessories such as bends, tees, reducers, and covers . Inspect all materials for damage, coating integrity, and compliance with specifications. Only approved and undamaged trays and accessories should be used . Store trays horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports to prevent warping and protect from moisture and sunlight .

2. Selecting the Right Cable Tray

- Ladder trays: Ideal for high-voltage or power cables due to excellent heat dissipation and visibility; lightweight and easy to clean .
- Trough trays: Fully enclosed, providing protection against dust, moisture, and interference; suitable for weak current or sensitive signal cables but with limited heat dissipation .



- Material considerations: Hot-dip galvanized steel is recommended for outdoor use; stainless steel or aluminum alloy may be used in corrosive environments .

3. Support and Hanger Installation

- Determine support spacing based on tray type and cable weight. Typical horizontal spacing is 1.5–3 meters, and vertical spacing should not exceed 2 meters .
- Supports can be trapeze hangers for ceiling suspension or cantilever wall brackets for wall-mounted trays .
- Ensure supports are level and aligned using a laser level to maintain straight tray runs .

4. Tray Assembly and Alignment

- Place trays on supports and connect sections using splice plates, ensuring edges are flush and interiors smooth to prevent cable damage .
- Tighten bolts carefully, allowing minor adjustments for alignment. Avoid over-tightening to prevent deformation .
- For long runs, include expansion joints to accommodate thermal expansion (typically every 30 meters for steel, 15 meters for aluminum), .

5. Grounding and Bonding

- Install grounding jumpers between tray sections using flexible copper wires to ensure electrical continuity .
- Do not rely solely on connecting bolts, as paint or oxide layers can interrupt the path. Proper grounding is critical for safety and code compliance .

6. Cable Laying and Fill Management

- Calculate total cable weight per meter to avoid overloading trays .
- Avoid overfilling to prevent overheating and physical damage. Ladder trays allow better ventilation, while ventilated troughs provide continuous support for smaller cables .
- Secure cables with ties or clamps at regular intervals to maintain organization and prevent sagging .

7. Inspection and Quality Assurance

- Conduct a final inspection to verify alignment, support integrity, grounding, and cable placement .
- Ensure compliance with NEC Article 392 and relevant standards such as NEMA VE 1 for load-bearing capacity and material quality . Following these steps ensures a robust, safe, and long-lasting cable tray system suitable for highway or large-scale infrastructure projects, minimizing maintenance and operational risks.
