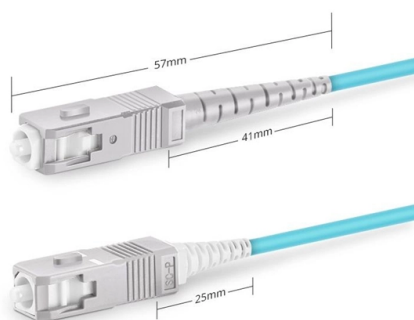

A distribution box (also called a DB box, consumer unit, or electrical panel) is the central hub of a home's electrical system. It receives power from the main supply and distributes it to various circuits throughout the house, ensuring safety and organization. Its primary role is to protect circuits from overloads and short circuits, prevent electrical hazards, and allow easy maintenance and monitoring of the system ().

Key Components

A typical distribution box contains:

- **Main Switch:** Controls the entire electrical system, allowing quick shutdown for emergencies or maintenance ().

- Outdoor Boxes: Designed for exposure to rain, sunlight, and temperature changes, often with higher IP ratings.
- Material Types: Plastic (thermoplastics like PC or ASA) for residential use, metal (stainless steel or epoxy-coated) for industrial or outdoor applications ().
- Smart DB Boxes: Include advanced monitoring, energy management, and remote control capabilities ().

- Count Circuits: Include all lighting, sockets, and high-power appliances, plus spare slots for future expansion ().
- Select Main Switch: Ensure it can handle the total load of the house.
- Include Safety Devices: RCBOs, surge protection devices (SPD), and reliable circuit breakers are essential for protection against faults and lightning ().

- Consider Material and Location: Choose indoor or outdoor-rated boxes and durable materials based on installation environment ().
