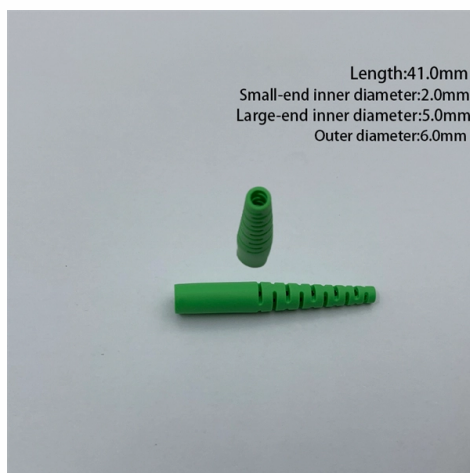


How are the support arms and cable trays fixed
