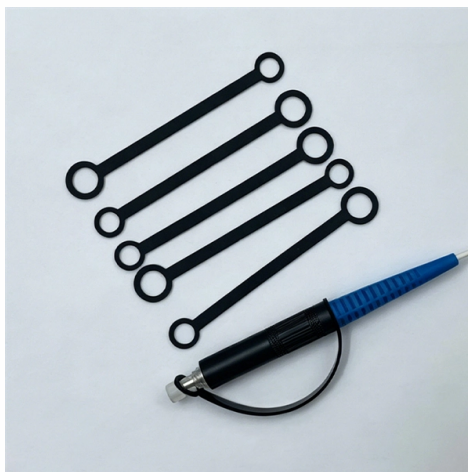


How do you cut a cable tray into a right-angle bend
