- Single connector scenario: If a repeater is installed at one end of a fiber link, the cable length it can support depends on the fiber type and the repeater's specifications. For single-mode fiber, this could be up to 160 km; for multimode fiber, practical distances are usually under 2 km .

Practical Considerations

- Installation environment: Short patch cords (0.5–2 m) are used for same-rack connections, medium lengths (3–5 m) for adjacent racks, and long cables (10 m+) for cross-row or inter-room connections (FS.com) .
- Signal quality: Attenuation and dispersion limit distance. High-quality fiber with low attenuation and optimized dispersion characteristics maximizes the effective range .
- Network speed: Higher data rates reduce the maximum distance for multimode fiber, making single-mode fiber preferable for long-haul links .
