

How long should a horizontal cable tray be before adding crossarms



Overview

Your cable tray length must always be longer than or equal to the support span you have selected. Matching the tray length to your support span can help control your splice. This publication is intended as a practical guide for the proper and safe* installation of cable ladder systems, cable tray systems, channel support systems and associated supports. Cable ladder systems and cable tray systems shall be manufactured in accordance with BS EN 61537, channel support. The standard NEMA lengths for cable tray are 12, 20, 24 and 30-feet, although some manufacturers like Eaton offer cable tray in lengths up to 40 feet.
