Before attempting to close any breaker, verify that the panel and circuits are safe to operate. Wear insulated gloves, use rubber-soled shoes, and ensure no water or conductive materials are nearby. Confirm that the breaker is in the “OFF” or open position and that the control system is ready for operation .

Manual Closing Procedure

- Locate the breaker and secondary disconnect: The secondary disconnect is often on the cubicle door or a remote control panel and interfaces with the breaker's auxiliary contacts .
- Check the “ready to close” indicator: Many breakers have a mechanical switch or lamp that shows if the trip latch is reset and the breaker is ready to close .
- Operate the close lever or switch: Firmly move the breaker handle or press the control switch to the “ON” or close position. This action engages the close coil, which charges the spring mechanism and closes the main contacts .

- Confirm closure: A red lamp or indicator typically illuminates when the breaker is energized, signaling that the circuit is live .

Electrically Controlled Closing

For breakers with remote or electrical control:

- Close coil activation: Energizing the close coil operates the breaker latch and charges the spring mechanism for instantaneous closing .
- Avoid “pumping”: If the breaker fails to close on the first attempt, the Y relay may lock out the circuit to prevent repeated cycling. Ensure the close signal is removed before retrying .
- Auxiliary contacts: These provide feedback to the control system, indicating whether the breaker is open or closed, which is essential for safe operation .

Verification

After closing the breaker, use a non-contact voltage tester or other approved testing device to confirm that power is present at the intended circuits. This step ensures the breaker is functioning correctly and that the circuit is energized safely .
