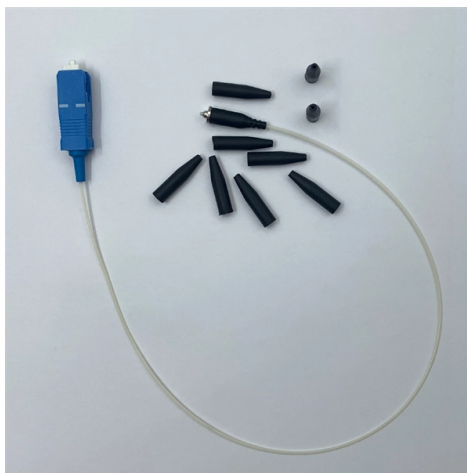


How to connect cable tray bolts

4. Tighten the Nuts Place nuts on the outside of the tray and tighten them using a spanner or torque wrench. Ensure the bolts are snug but avoid over-tightening, which could deform the tray or strip threads .
5. Ensure Electrical Continuity If the splice plate is not rated for grounding, install a copper bonding jumper across the joint to maintain electrical continuity. This step is critical for safety and compliance with grounding practices .
6. Inspect the Connection Check that the tray sections are firmly joined, level, and free of gaps. Verify that all bolts are tightened and that the grounding jumper is properly installed. This ensures system stability and long-term durability .

Tools and Materials Needed

- Splice plates (couplers)
 - Mushroom-head bolts and nuts
 - Spanner or torque wrench
 - Copper bonding jumper (if required)
 - Level and measuring tape
