

How to connect fiber optic cables to a switch panel

 - **Connect Fiber to Patch Panel:** Remove protective covers and insert the fiber optic cables into the patch panel ports, ensuring secure connections .
 - **Link Patch Panel to Switch:** Connect the other end of the fiber cables from the patch panel to the SFP/SFP+ modules on the switch. For duplex connections, ensure the transmit and receive fibers are correctly aligned .
 - **Check Link Lights:** Power on the switch and verify that the link lights on both the switch and patch panel indicate a successful connection .
 - **Test the Connection:** Use a fiber optic tester to confirm signal integrity and proper data transmission .

- **Clean Connectors:** Dust or debris can degrade signal quality; always clean connectors before connecting .
 - **Use Pre-Terminated Cables:** Pre-terminated fiber cables with LC connectors save time and reduce installation errors .
 - **Label Cables:** Clearly label each fiber strand to simplify troubleshooting and future maintenance .
 - **Check Port Mode:** Ensure the switch port is set to fiber mode if it has combo ports .
