

How to connect two Cisco switches using fiber optic cable

Step 1: Choose the Fiber Type

For short distances (less than 25 meters), multimode fiber (MMF) is recommended because it is cost-effective and supports high-speed connections over short runs . Single-mode fiber (SMF) is typically used for longer distances.

Step 2: Select SFP or SFP+ Modules

- SFP modules support 1 Gbps connections, while SFP+ modules support 10 Gbps.
- Ensure the SFP module matches the switch port type and the fiber type (multimode or single-mode) .
- For example, a Cisco 2960 switch with 2 SFP ports can use 1G SFP modules for multimode fiber.

Step 3: Use Duplex Fiber Cabling

- Use duplex fiber optic cables (two strands) to handle separate transmit (TX) and receive (RX) signals .

- Pre-terminated cables with LC connectors are recommended for ease of installation and reliability .

- Ensure the fiber strands are connected in a crossed manner: TX on one switch connects to RX on the other, and vice versa.

Step 4: Connect the Switches

- Insert the SFP modules into the SFP ports on both switches.

- Connect the duplex fiber cable between the SFP modules, ensuring proper TX/RX alignment.

- Verify the link lights on the SFP ports are active.

Step 5: Configure the Switch Interfaces

- Enable the SFP interfaces if they are administratively down:

```
interface GigabitEthernet1/0/1 no shutdown
```

- Assign VLANs as needed to allow communication between devices on both switches .

- For redundancy, consider EtherChannel by connecting two fiber cables and configuring them as a single logical link to prevent loops and increase bandwidth .

Step 6: Verify Connectivity

- Use show interface status and ping commands to confirm the link is operational.

- Ensure VLANs are properly propagated and devices on both switches can communicate. By following these steps, you can establish a reliable fiber optic connection between two Cisco switches, with options for redundancy and high-speed data transfer. Proper SFP selection, duplex cabling, and interface configuration are key to success .
