Mounting the Distribution Box

Connecting the Wires

- Incoming wires:
- Connect the live (phase) wire (usually brown or red) to the main terminal.
- Connect the neutral wire (blue or black) to the neutral bar.

- Connect the ground wire (green/yellow) to the earth bar .
- Circuit breakers:
 - Install breakers in the designated slots.
- Connect each circuit wire to its corresponding breaker according to the intended load .
- Outgoing circuits:
 - Wire the outgoing circuits to the breakers, ensuring each wire is correctly marked for identification .
- Wire arrangement:
 - Arrange wires neatly, secure with zip ties, and leave space for heat dissipation .

Verification and Testing

- Use a multimeter to check for proper connections, continuity, and absence of short circuits .
- Confirm that breakers and fuses are correctly rated for the circuits .
- Perform a final inspection to ensure all terminals are tight, wires are insulated, and components are functioning properly .

Common Issues to Avoid

- Incorrect wiring: Double-check that each wire is connected to the correct terminal.
- Loose connections: Tighten all screws and terminals securely.
- Overloading circuits: Do not exceed the distribution box's rated capacity.
