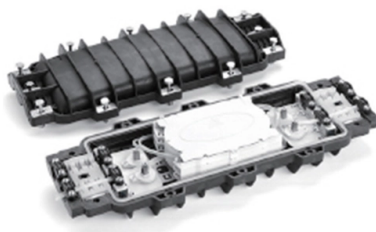

Fiber optic cables transmit data as light through delicate glass fibers, which can be damaged easily. They may also emit invisible infrared laser light, which can harm your eyes if viewed directly. Always disconnect power from the equipment before handling the cable and wear protective eyewear if necessary. Work slowly and avoid bending, twisting, or applying lateral force to the cable .

Identify Connector Type

Common fiber optic connectors include:

- SC and SC/APC: Rectangular push/pull latching connectors
- LC: Compact connectors with a lift-and-pull release



- ST: Twist-and-lock bayonet style Knowing the connector type helps you use the correct disengagement method and prevents damage .
Step-by-Step Disconnection
- Power Down Equipment: Turn off the modem, ONT, or other connected devices to eliminate laser hazards.
- Release the Connector: Use the appropriate mechanism for your connector type:
 - SC/SC-APC: Press the latch and pull straight out
 - LC: Lift the release tab and pull along the connector axis
 - ST: Twist counterclockwise and pull
- Avoid Excess Force: If the connector resists, stop immediately to prevent fiber breakage.
- Cap Exposed Ends: Place protective caps on both the cable and device ports to prevent contamination and signal loss .
After Disconnection

Inspect the cable and connectors for damage before reconnecting or storing. Avoid touching the fiber ends, and keep them clean using lint-free wipes or fiber cleaning tools if necessary . If connectors are stuck, damaged, or recessed, contact your ISP or a certified technician rather than forcing removal . Following these steps ensures that the fiber optic cable is safely disabled without compromising the cable integrity or your safety.
