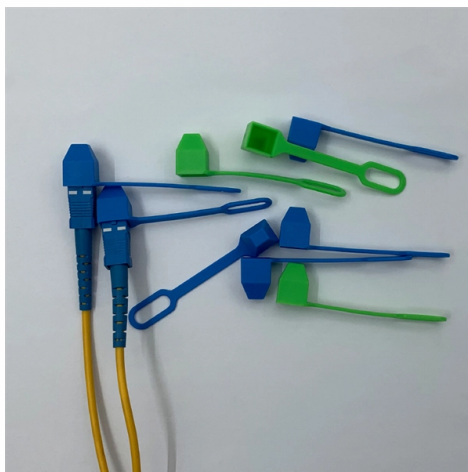


How to drill holes for fiber optic connectors
