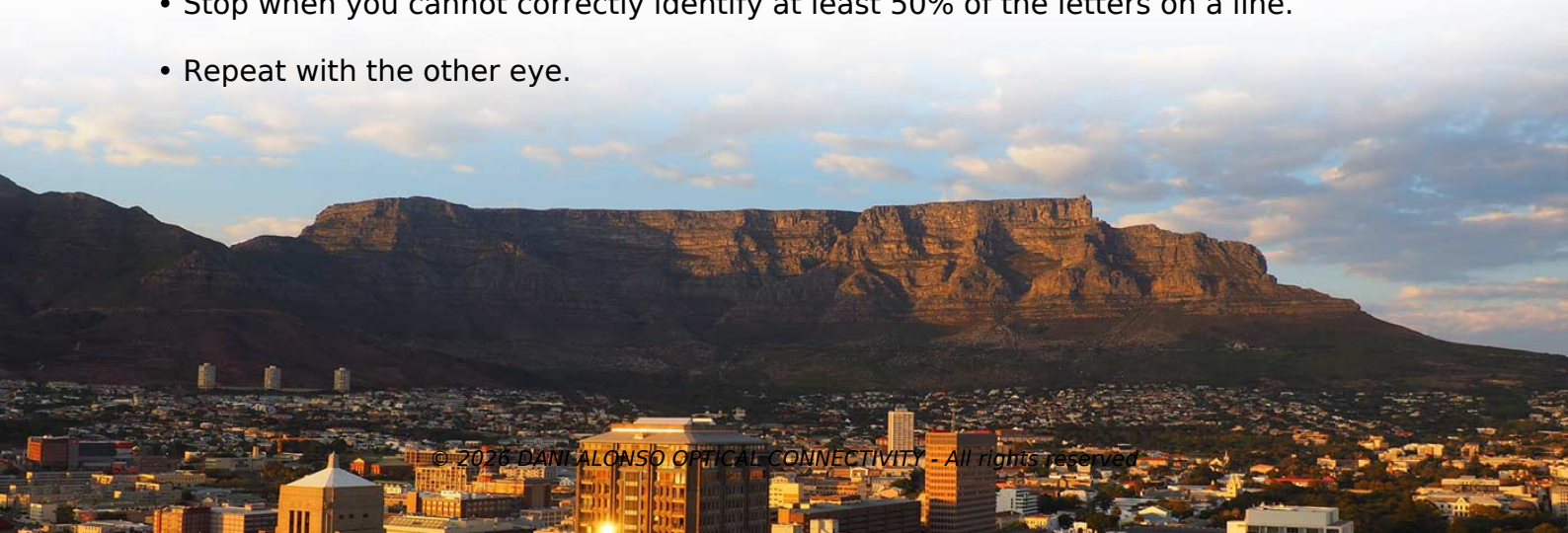

Eye charts are tools to measure visual acuity, the sharpness of your vision. The most common type is the Snellen chart, which has rows of letters decreasing in size from top to bottom. Other charts include the Tumbling E, Landolt C, and Jaeger chart for near vision or non-readers . To read an eye chart:

- Stand at the standardized distance (usually 10-20 feet for Snellen charts).
- Cover one eye completely without pressing on it.
- Start reading the largest letters at the top, moving to smaller letters line by line.
- Stop when you cannot correctly identify at least 50% of the letters on a line.
- Repeat with the other eye.



- Your visual acuity is expressed as a fraction (e.g., 20/40), where the numerator is your distance from the chart and the denominator is the distance a person with normal vision can read the same line .

Integrating Huijue Techniques

Huijue emphasizes mindful vision exercises to strengthen the eyes and improve clarity naturally . When using an eye chart with Huijue:

- Relax your eyes and mind before starting. Take deep breaths and focus on the chart without tension.
- Follow the letters or symbols slowly, moving your gaze in different directions (up, down, left, right, or counterclockwise) to exercise eye muscles.
- Alternate focus distances: glance at the chart, then a nearby object, then back to the chart to train accommodation.
- Use both eyes together after single-eye practice to improve binocular coordination.
- Track progress: note which lines you can read comfortably over time, gradually attempting smaller letters as your eyes strengthen.

Tips for Effective Practice

- Perform exercises in a well-lit environment to reduce strain.
- Avoid squinting; let your eyes adjust naturally.
- Combine eye chart reading with other Huijue exercises, such as following shapes or patterns, to enhance retinal activity and visual memory.
- Be consistent: short daily sessions are more effective than occasional long sessions. By combining standard eye chart reading with Huijue's mindful eye exercises, you can monitor your visual acuity while actively training your eyes to improve focus, clarity, and overall visual health .
