

How to secure cable trays after erection



Overview

Cables on face-up horizontally fixed tray must be secured by use of the tie wraps where not in view. If cables are bunched or single cables greater than 25sq mm are installed, cleats or metal straps shall be used. This guide covers the critical steps, from selecting the right electrical cable tray and performing accurate cable fill calculations to managing a safe cable pull through and ensuring all bonding and grounding requirements are met. To ensure effective cable tray covers installation, precise measurements, quality materials. Cable ladder systems and cable tray systems shall be manufactured in accordance with BS EN 61537, channel support.
