

How to set up a router after installing a new ADSL fiber optic connection

Step 1: Connect the Fiber Optic Cable to the ONT

Locate the fiber optic wall outlet where your ISP's fiber line enters your home. Remove the protective caps from both the fiber cable and the ONT's optical port. Carefully insert the fiber connector into the ONT's input port until it clicks securely. Handle the fiber cable by its plastic housing to avoid damage or dirt contamination. Power on the ONT and wait 2-5 minutes for the status lights to stabilize, indicating a successful connection to the ISP network .

Step 2: Link the ONT to Your Router

Use a standard Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN or Ethernet output port to the WAN (or Internet) port on your router. Ensure the router is placed near a power outlet and in a dry, ventilated area. Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm an active connection .

Step 3: Configure the Router

Open a web browser on a connected device and enter the router's IP address (commonly 192.168.1.1). Log in using the default credentials provided with your router. Enter your ISP-provided username and password if required, and select the connection type (DHCP or PPPoE) as instructed by your ISP. Update the router firmware to the latest version to ensure optimal performance and security .

Step 4: Set Up Wi-Fi and Security

Configure your Wi-Fi network by setting a unique SSID (network name) and a strong password. Enable WPA3 or WPA2 encryption for security. Position the router centrally in your home to maximize coverage. For critical devices like gaming consoles or workstations, consider using wired Ethernet connections for faster speeds and lower latency .

Step 5: Test and Optimize

Check that all devices can connect to the internet. Test your connection speed to ensure it matches your ISP plan. Adjust router settings such as Quality of Service (QoS) if needed to prioritize bandwidth for specific applications. Regularly monitor performance and update firmware to maintain security and reliability . Following these steps ensures your fiber optic connection is properly linked to your router, your home network is secure, and you can fully leverage the high-speed capabilities of fiber internet.
