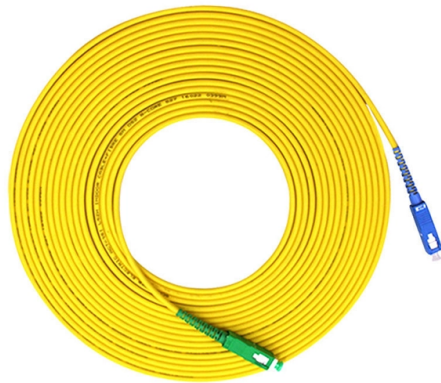


How to wire the round plug in the distribution box

To wire a round plug in a distribution box, connect the phase (live) wire to the MCB output, the neutral wire to the neutral bus, and the earth wire to the earth bus, following proper color coding and safety standards.

- Turn Off Power Ensure the main supply to the distribution box is switched off to prevent electric shock.
- Identify Wires
 - Phase (Live): Usually red, brown, or yellow
 - Neutral: Blue
 - Earth: Green/yellow striped Confirm the wire colors comply with your local electrical standards ().
- Connect to Protective Devices
 - If the plug is for a high-power appliance, use a Double Pole MCB; for standard loads, a Single Pole MCB is sufficient ().
- Connect the phase wire from the plug to the output terminal of the MCB.

- Connect the neutral wire to the neutral bus bar.
- Connect the earth wire to the earth bus bar or earth link in the distribution box ().
- Secure the Wires
- Strip the insulation carefully without damaging the copper strands.
- Insert the wires fully into the terminals and tighten screws securely.
- Use plastic ties to organize wires neatly and prevent accidental contact ().
- Check Connections
- Ensure no bare wires are exposed.
- Verify that the phase, neutral, and earth are correctly connected and that the MCB rating matches the load ().
- Power On and Test
- Switch on the main supply.
- Test the plug with a suitable appliance or a multimeter to confirm correct voltage and grounding.

Safety Tips

- Always follow local electrical codes and standards.
 - If unsure, consult a licensed electrician.
 - Never connect wires while the distribution box is live.
 - Clearly mark the circuits and voltage levels inside the box for future reference ().
- By following these steps, the round plug will be safely and correctly wired to the distribution box, ensuring proper operation and protection against electrical hazards.
