The ground wire in a distribution box serves as a safety path for electrical faults, preventing electric shock and protecting equipment from surges or short circuits. It remains inactive during normal operation but becomes critical if a live conductor contacts metal parts, directing current safely to earth .

Wire Sizing and Standards

- In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) ground wire is typically used for distribution boxes .
- In other markets, a 6 mm² wire is standard .
- For connections between mounting plates and equipment like spindle plates, larger wires may be required (e.g., 16 mm² or 6 AWG) to maintain low resistance .



- The ground resistance between all system parts should be less than 0.1 Ohm to ensure effective grounding .

Connection Points

- Distribution Box Housing: Attach the ground wire to a dedicated threaded stud or ground terminal at the bottom of the enclosure .
- Mounting Plate: Connect a second wire from the mounting plate to the central grounding point of the facility .
- Earth Bar: Inside the distribution box, the ground wire is typically connected to an earth bar, which distributes grounding to all outgoing circuits .

Installation Tips

- Use yellow-green striped wires for grounding to comply with standard color codes .
- Ensure secure connections with proper torque on studs and terminals.
- Avoid double-tapping neutrals or grounding points to prevent potential faults .
- Test the grounding system after installation to verify resistance is within safe limits (≤ 25 Ohms for general installations,
