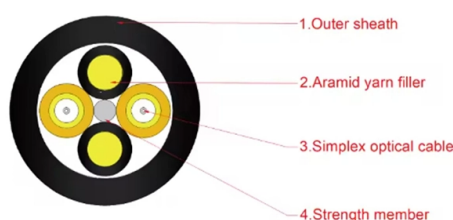


Incoming line from the distribution box outlet
