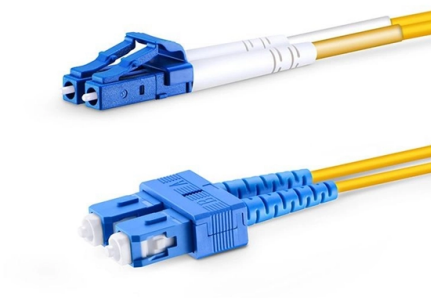


Installation of Waterproof Cover for Distribution Box

Choose a waterproof distribution box made from moisture-resistant materials such as ABS or polycarbonate, rated IP65–IP66 for outdoor use. Ensure the box has sealed seams, high-quality gaskets, and UV-stabilized housing if exposed to sunlight, and consider transparent covers for easy monitoring of internal components .

Mounting the Box

- Assess the site to confirm the structural integrity of the mounting surface .
- Drill rear mounting holes according to the manufacturer's template, ensuring precise leveling.
- Fix the box using expansion bolts with rubber sealing washers to prevent water ingress .



- For outdoor installations, install the box at a slight downward angle to promote water runoff .

Sealing Cable Entries

- Pierce pre-molded knockout holes at the bottom or top for cable entry .
- Install liquid-tight cable glands with rubber gaskets, ensuring compression of at least 10% of the cable diameter to prevent water penetration .
- Apply silicone sealant around edges and cable entry points for additional waterproofing .

Installing Internal Components

- Use DIN rails or internal mounting plates made of galvanized steel or reinforced fiberglass .
- Maintain 15mm clearance for heat dissipation.
- Mount circuit breakers, terminal blocks, and other components securely on the rails or pillars.
- Connect the main grounding wire to the internal brass earth terminal block .

Securing the Cover

- Ensure the gasket is fully compressed when closing the lid to maintain IP rating .
- Use stainless steel latches or fasteners torqued according to manufacturer specifications.
- Periodically re-torque fasteners to compensate for thermal cycling and prevent gasket separation .

Additional Tips

- Use outdoor-rated switches and sockets with rubber gaskets.
- Regularly inspect and maintain the box, checking for cracks, gasket wear, or water ingress.
- For solar PV or EV applications, ensure proper consolidation of DC circuits and secure cable routing to prevent moisture-related failures . By following these steps, the waterproof protective cover and distribution box will provide long-term protection against moisture, dust, UV exposure, and mechanical impacts, ensuring reliable electrical performance in outdoor or industrial environments .
