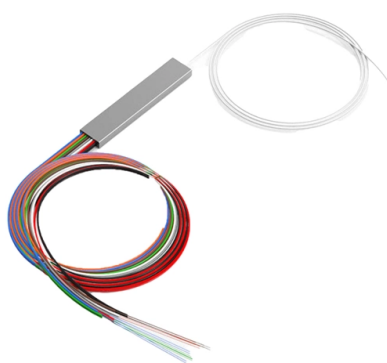

#### Cable Trough vs Cable Tray

- Cable tray: Broad category encompassing all tray types used to support and route cables.
- Cable trough: A specific type of cable tray with a partially enclosed design for better protection and continuous cable support.
- Solid bottom tray: Similar to a trough tray but fully enclosed, offering maximum protection against dust, moisture, and electromagnetic interference .

In summary, all troughs are cable trays, but not all cable trays are troughs. The term "cable trough" usually refers to a tray with a partially enclosed bottom, emphasizing protection and continuous support, whereas "cable tray" is the general term for any tray system used to manage cables.
