A meter box is an electrical enclosure designed to house the electricity meter and related service connections. It serves as the interface between the utility power supply and the consumer's internal electrical system, typically installed at the point of entry or on an exterior wall for easy access by utility personnel . Meter boxes protect the meter from weather, tampering, and accidental contact, ensuring safe and authorized access. They are primarily used for measuring energy consumption for billing and monitoring purposes .

Distribution Boxes

A distribution box (DB box) is an enclosure that receives power from the main supply and distributes it to multiple branch circuits within a building . It houses protective devices such as MCBs, RCCBs, or RCBOs to safeguard circuits against overloads, short circuits, and leakage currents. Distribution boxes are usually installed indoors in service rooms or accessible locations for routine operation and maintenance . They ensure that electricity flows safely to lighting, appliances, and equipment while preventing electrical faults .

Components of a Distribution Box

- Circuit breakers or fuses: Protect individual circuits from overcurrent or short circuits.
- Bus bars: Distribute current to multiple circuits.
- Indication lights: Show the status of mains power supply.
- Optional smart modules: Enable energy monitoring and integration with home automation systems .

Applications

- Residential: Breaker boxes, meter panels, and small DB boxes for homes.
- Commercial: Standard circuit breaker panels and custom enclosures for offices or shops.
- Industrial: Medium-voltage panels, control panels, and junction boxes for factories or large facilities .
- Temporary or portable setups: Power distribution boxes for events or construction sites, often with IP-rated enclosures for weather protection .
