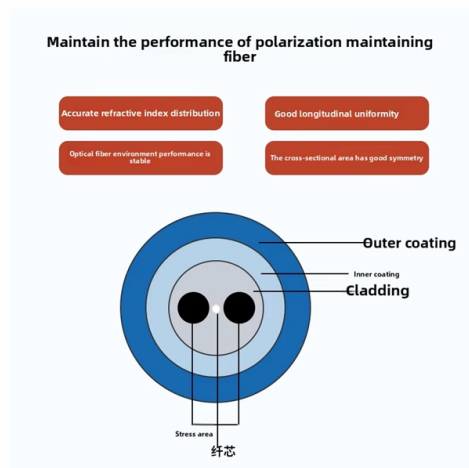


Mobile Router Fiber Optic Light On
