Fiber internet requires an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert fiber signals into Ethernet. You cannot replace the ONT with a standard modem, but you can connect almost any compatible router to the ONT's Ethernet port. Your router must have a Gigabit Ethernet WAN port and support the speed tier of your fiber plan to avoid bottlenecks. Older routers (Wi-Fi 4 or Wi-Fi 5) may limit speeds, so a Wi-Fi 6 or 6E router is recommended for optimal performance and device management .

Steps to Replace Your Router

- **Confirm ONT Setup:** Ensure your ISP has installed and activated the ONT.
- **Check Compatibility:** Verify your router supports the required WAN connection, speed, and Wi-Fi standards.
- **Connect Router:** Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT to your router's WAN port.

- **Configure Settings:** Access the router's admin panel to update VLAN, DHCP, or PPPoE settings if required by your ISP.

- **Optimize Placement:** Position the router centrally in your home to reduce dead zones and extend Wi-Fi coverage .

Considerations and Potential Issues

Replacing the ISP-provided router can improve Wi-Fi performance and customization, but some users experience setup difficulties, connection issues, or speed limitations if the router is not fully compatible with the ISP's network . Some ISPs may also require authentication or specific settings, so check for any restrictions before switching.

Alternative: 5G Mobile Routers

For users seeking flexibility or avoiding physical installation, 5G mobile routers with eSIMs are a viable alternative. These devices provide fast internet without cables, are portable, and can be activated via a QR code. They are particularly useful for renters, temporary setups, or frequent relocations. 5G routers are future-proof as networks expand, and monthly data plans are often cheaper than traditional fiber contracts .
