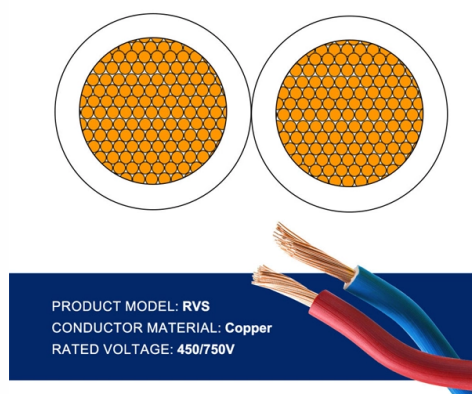

- Turn off power before wiring and verify with an electrical tester .
- Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas matching load requirements .
- Ensure neat cable management, proper insulation, and correct wire gauge and breaker size .
- Connect phase, neutral, and ground wires securely, and maintain sufficient spacing for heat dissipation .
- Label all circuits clearly and consider modular designs for future upgrades .

Safety and Protection

- Ground the metal enclosure, electrical board, and internal appliances reliably .
- Connect the protective neutral wire through a terminal board.
- Install circuit breakers, fuses, and surge protectors for each circuit .
- Perform insulation and continuity tests before energizing the box .
- Operators should wear personal protective equipment such as insulating gloves, safety glasses, and slip-resistant shoes .

Compliance and Standards

- Follow local and international standards such as NEC, IEC, or GB/T codes .
- Use UL/CE-certified components to ensure safety and reliability .
- Document installation details, including wiring diagrams, mounting clearances, and protective devices, for future inspections and maintenance .

Maintenance

- Schedule regular inspections to check for loose connections, corrosion, or damage .
- Maintain clean and unobstructed access to breakers and fuses for routine operations .
