Overview

The fiber optic 90-degree bend refers to the minimum radius required when cables must change direction at right angles. Similar to how a garden hose restricts water flow when kinked, fiber optic cables experience performance degradation or complete signal loss when bent too sharply. 65 CM sheathing, except for one flat cable. Thanks Ethernet is usually fairly forgiving of most bends, unless it's super-kinked, especially if it's a static run and isn't moving. Solutions to. A part of the cable run involves tacking the cable along just above the skirting board but the problem is the cable need to bend around a 90 degree corner and I hear you shouldnt bend this type of cable as it will damage it, websites seem to state I need a 1 inch radius for the bend which will mean. New cable fixed the issue, but 3 months after switching the cable, I'm back to 100mbps.
