Patch panels are typically installed in 19-inch racks, server rooms, or wiring closets, providing a neat and accessible termination point for Ethernet, fiber optic, or coaxial cables (). Types of Patch Panels

- Twisted-Pair Copper Patch Panels
- Designed for Ethernet standards such as Cat5e, Cat6, or Cat6a.
- Feature RJ45 connectors on the front and color-coded IDC termination blocks on the rear.
- Often include gold-plated connectors, durable metal frames, and cable management features ().

- Fiber Optic Patch Panels
- Support optical connectors like LC, SC, or ST.
- Provide the same labeling and cable management benefits as copper panels but are optimized for fiber connections ().
- Coaxial Patch Panels
- Commonly used in audio/visual installations rather than LAN networks.
- Facilitate organized connections for video or broadcast systems ().
