According to NFPA 70E, the default practice is to de-energize electrical equipment before performing any work to prevent shocks, arc flashes, and injuries. Energized work is only permitted if the employer documents that de-energizing would create additional hazards or is operationally infeasible, such as maintaining critical systems or performing necessary testing that cannot be done with the equipment de-energized. Convenience or time savings are not valid reasons for live work. OSHA standards (1910.269 and 1926.960) require that any work on energized equipment, especially above 50 volts, be performed by qualified personnel using proper minimum approach distances and protective measures. At least two employees should be present for high-voltage work, and workers must be insulated from simultaneous contact with energized and grounded conductors.

Protective Measures and Equipment



When replacing a distribution box while energized, workers must use Insulating Protective Equipment (IPE), including:

- Rubber gloves with protectors and insulating sleeves
- Insulating blankets, line hoses, and covers
- Live-line tools such as hot sticks or switchsticks for primary distribution systems
- Insulated aerial lifts or platforms when required All equipment must be tested regularly (e.g., rubber gloves every 12 months) and workers must be trained and proficient in live work techniques . The work area should be controlled to prevent accidental contact with energized parts, and proper grounding procedures must be followed if temporary grounding is necessary.

Best Practices

- Conduct a risk assessment and document justification for energized work.
- Ensure all personnel are qualified and trained in NFPA 70E and OSHA live work procedures.
- Use barriers, covers, and insulating tools to minimize exposure to live parts.
- Maintain communication and coordination among team members, especially for emergency response.
- Avoid performing energized work alone; always have a buddy system in place .
