

Requirements for lintels during distribution box installation



Overview

Steel Lintels should be installed with a minimum end bearing of 150mm, bedded on mortar and levelled along its length and across its width. The masonry above the lintel should be built in accordance with BS EN 1996-2:2006. sharper than those of mild steel lintels ! Use of g oves is recommended to handle the lintels ! The weight of some lintels may require the use of a crane; rotext fabric strops from the sharp edges ! The lintels may contain CFC-free polystyrene or Rock efer to our technical dept. Raise the inner and outer leaves simultaneously to avoid excessive. Follow these instructions for the successful installation of concrete lintels. All Hi-Spec, Fair Faced and Fire Spec lintels are marked 'TOP'. Please consult Leviat's Technical Team when using reduced bearings for revised capacities.

Installation Guidelines Box Section Lintels

Health & Safety ! Point loads must be flat on the lintel, bear over at least 50mm of the lintel length, and must be either against the web (DB lintels) or all the way across the box section:

Composite lintels (i.e. "CXHD", "CH" and "RSC") should be adequately propped during construction, at maximum centres of 1.2 metres. The props should not be removed until the mortar has cured.
