- Schedule for re-inspection after corrective actions 6. Signatures and Declaration
- Installer or inspector signature
- Date of inspection

- Statement confirming that the inspection was conducted with reasonable skill and care, and that the report accurately reflects the condition of the installation 7.
- Attachments

- Test result sheets
- Photographs of the installation
- Calibration certificates of instruments used

- Use a structured checklist to ensure all items are covered
- Record all measurements and observations clearly

- Maintain a copy of the report for future reference and compliance verification
- Ensure that any defects are addressed promptly and re-tested before commissioning By following this structure, your self-inspection report will provide a comprehensive record of the distribution box installation, demonstrating compliance with safety standards and readiness for operation.
